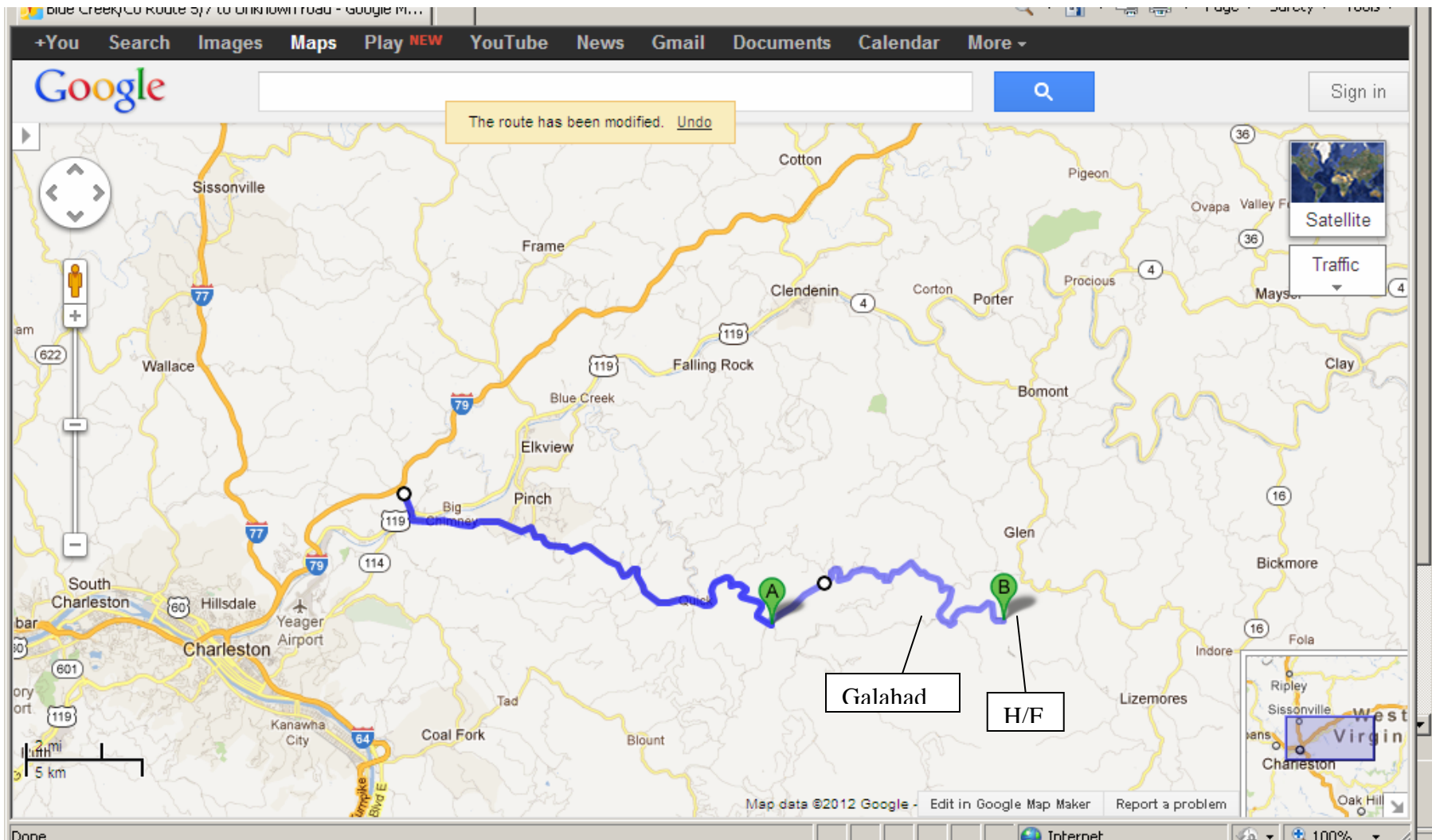
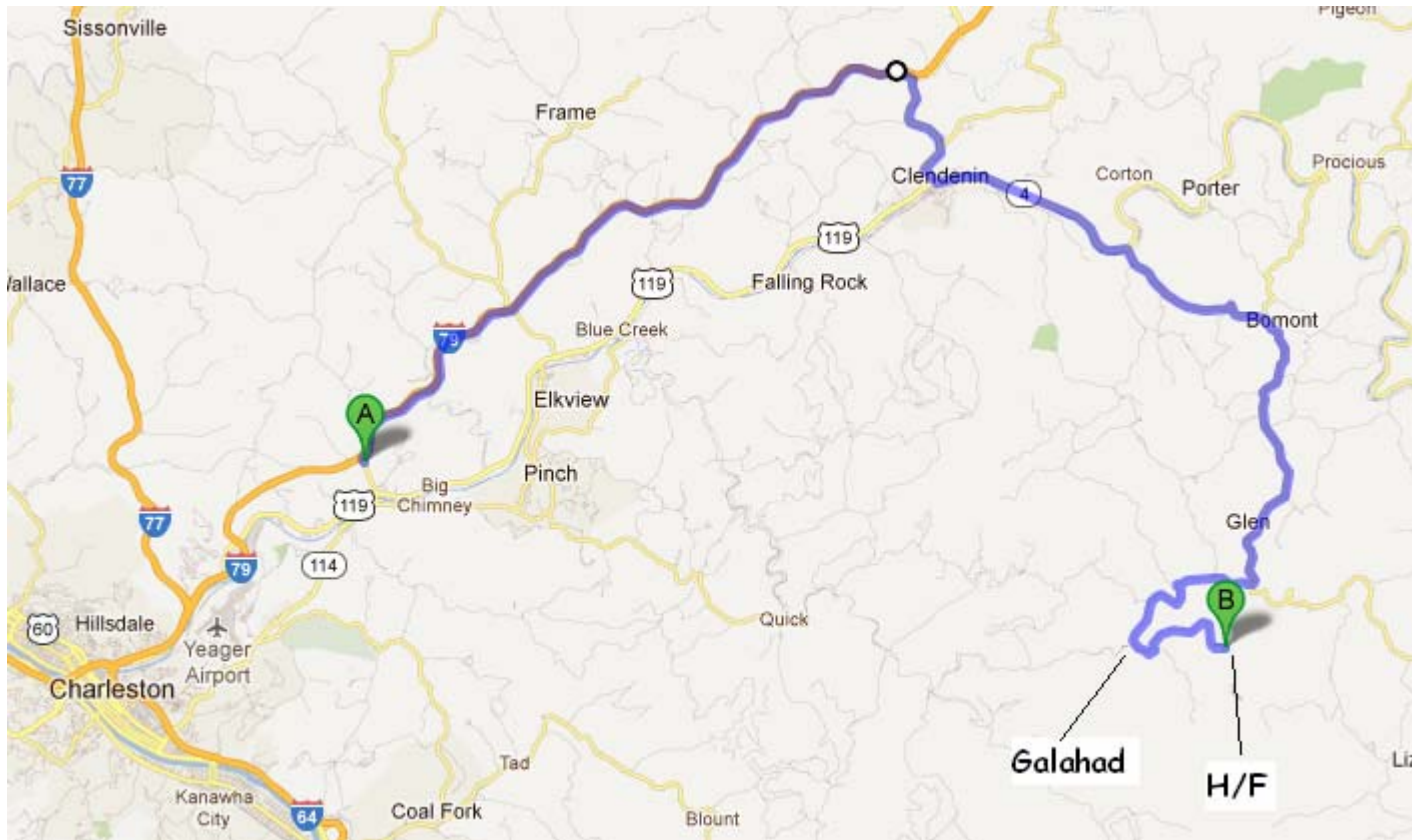


It would be too bad, perhaps, not to be able to go downhill directly across Dutch Ridge from where the road from Glen gets to the top of the hill, no matter how we got to that crossroads. As I remember it, the road between the H/F lodge along the creek to the old walk-in can be pretty rough and wet. Better to stay on high ground when we can...



Compare this Sanderson (A) route with the Clendenin-to-Glen route on the next page. Looks a lot shorter, but a lot more curvy. It is on the high ground until the sharp right turn down the hill to Galahad. Then up the creek to the H/F turn-off.

There are enough unknowns that I'd want someone to try it before I recommend it. Dutch Ridge Road was (a few years ago) newly paved and well maintained, albeit narrow. A fun drive, really.



Here's the other way, if we can't use the direct downhill to the H/F. Go to Clendenin and Glen, and at the top of the hill take Dutch Ridge Road west to the Galahad downhill... Appears up to 50% longer!

There is a third way – To Sanderson and just right up the creek through the camps sites and through Galahad to the H/F. I'd think that was the most unreliable way, due to many creek crossings and low country. A little bit of rain before the event could cause real trouble.
